Contents of the Rulebook

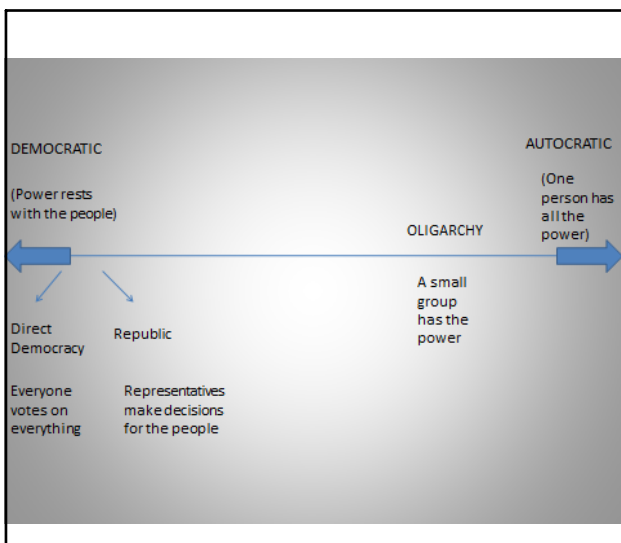
To create the rulebook for your island's government, you must decide:
