3. Place the letter for each item below on the appropriate place on the map.
 - a. Independent Balkan state on the Adriatic Sea
 - b. Empire north of the Black Sea
 - c. Region on the Black Sea administered by Ottoman Empire (Turkey).
 - d. Region on the Adriatic Sea occupied by Austria
 - e. Nation between Austria-Hungary and the Russian Empire
 - f. Independent nation bordering Bosnia-Herzegovina on the east
 - g. Independent Black Sea nation bordering Russia
 - h. Independent Balkan state south of the Ottoman Empire
4. Name the five sovereign nations in Balkans.
5. Which of the five sovereign nations in the Balkans border Austria-Hungary?
6. Which border Russia?
7. How does this map illustrate the influence of nationalism and the decline of the Ottoman Empire in the 1800's?
