- **Conflict**: clash of ideas or a fight/battle
- Democracy: a government in which the people hold the power, rights & vote
- Fascism: a system of government with a one party system guided by a single strong ruler; glorification of the nation is emphasized; aggressive; capitalists
- Isolationism: a belief that one's country should not take part in international affairs

Conflict Unit Terms Continued

- Dictatorship: a government in which a single ruler has complete power over a country
- Alliance: nations joined together by treaty and/or agreement
- Genocide: the deliberate destruction of a certain ethnic or religious group
- Propaganda: the spreading of information, ideas, etc. in a way meant to make others accept them; think, feel & act a certain way

Conflict Unit Terms Continued

- Nationalism: pride in one's country
 - Appeasement: to give someone something in order to avoid conflict
 - Aggression: hostile behavior
 - Totalitarianism: a single party dictatorship that controls every aspect of the lives of its citizens
 - Communism: government that controls all resources, land, industry is owned by
