

## Middle Ages vs Enlightenment

- **500-1500**
- Geography: Europe
- History: After Fall of Roman Empire
- Beliefs: Roman
  Catholic, church final authority & explained the unknown, superstitious, excommunication

- 1650-1700's
- Geography: Same
- History: After Renaissance
- Beliefs: Protestant
  Reformation
  challenged the R.C.
  Church, emphasis on
  reason, science used
  to explain unknown



## Continued . . .

- Economic: manorial system, self sufficient, little trade, bartering, peasants
- Political: Feudal System, land=power, land needed to be protected so loyalty exchanged for land
- Social: Two classes-King w/ nobles & commoners; few educated

- Economic: based on trade(merchants), sought gold w/ emphasis of exports, colonies important
- Political: Absolute
  Monarch w/ nobility &
  everyone else subjects of
  the king
- Social: Three classes-king, middle class, commoners
