BENEFITS OF IMPERIALISM

We feel . . . our rule . . . has brought security and peace and comparative prosperity to countries that never knew these blessings before . . . You cannot destroy the practices of barbarism, of slavery, of superstition, which for centuries have [ruined] the interior of Africa, without the use of force. . . . But . . . we may rest assured that . . . the cause of civilization . . . will in the long run be [greatly] advanced. (European perspective)
