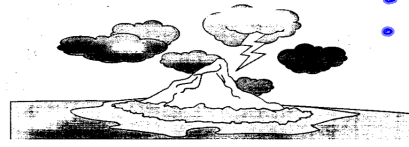

Creating a Government

Contents of the Rulebook

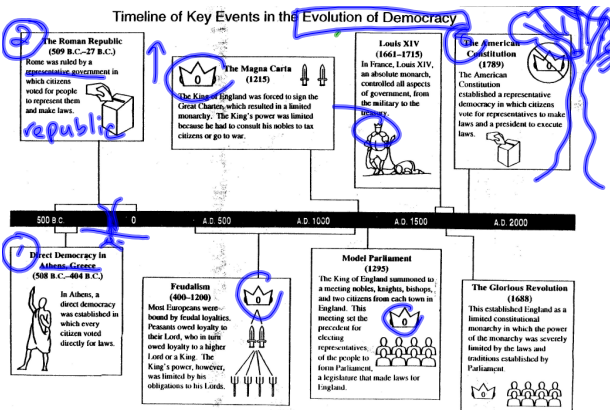
To create the rulebook for your island's government, you must decide:

- On a name and flag for your island.
- Who in the class will perform the following duties; hunting and gathering food, cooking food, making shelter, exploring the rest of the island, fishing for food, and caring for the ill.
- How your community will determine if someone is guilty of breaking rules.
- What, if any, will be the punishment for those who do not obey rules.
- Any other rules you wish to have for your community.
- How you will make rules in the future and who will make them.
