
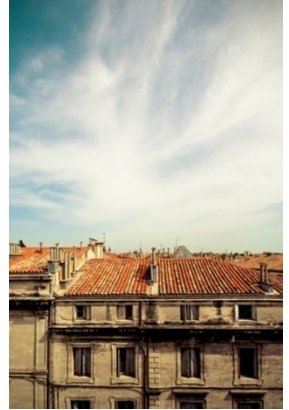


Britain's Response to the Industrial Revolution

 - Medical officer and sanitary inspector 
 - By end of 19th Century – improved conditions
 - Purified h₂o, sewers, police force, public baths and wash houses



The Factory Acts

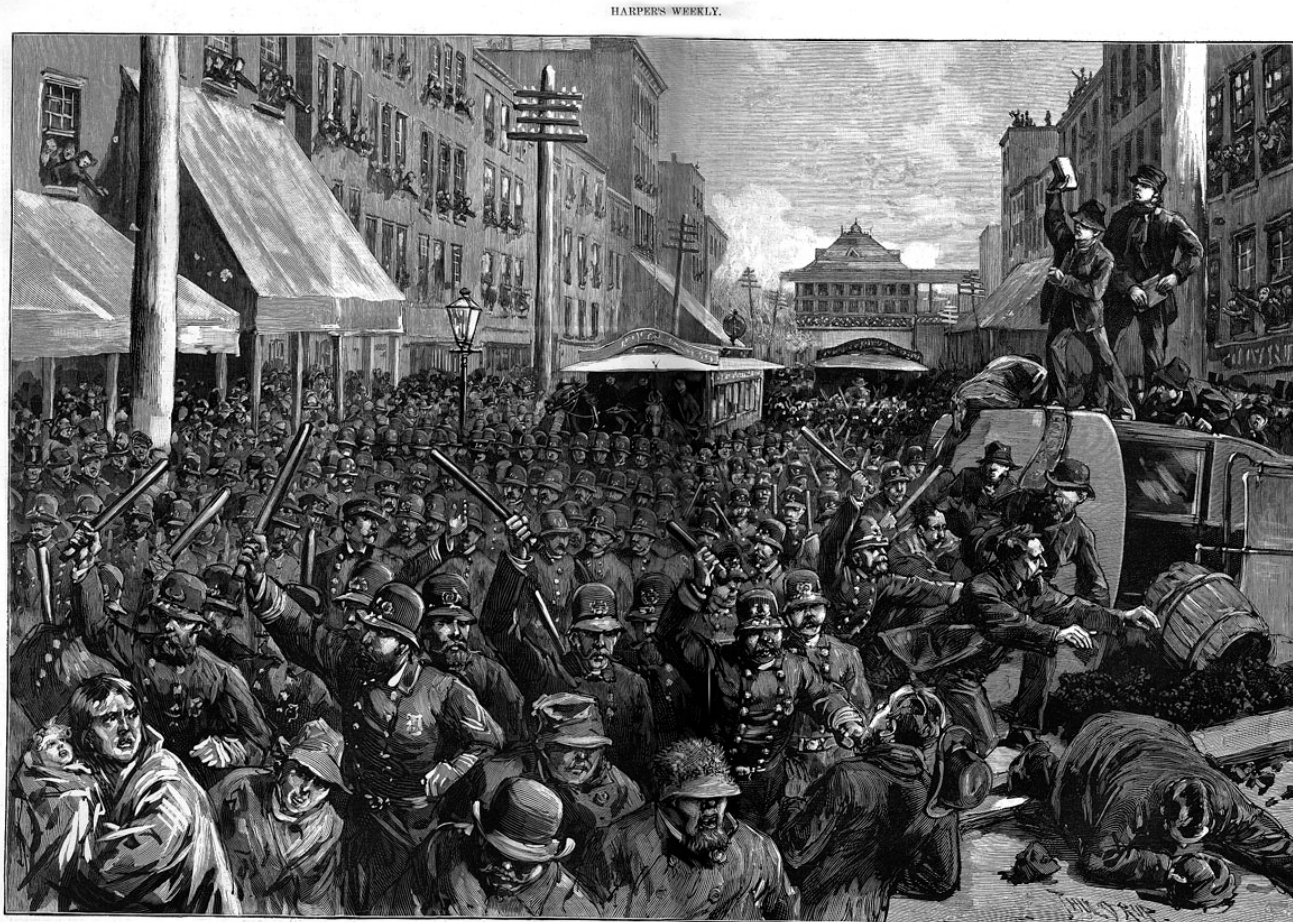
- Limited working hours of children and women
- Required attendance at schools



- Fences around machines – fewer accidents



Britain's Response to the Industrial Revolution



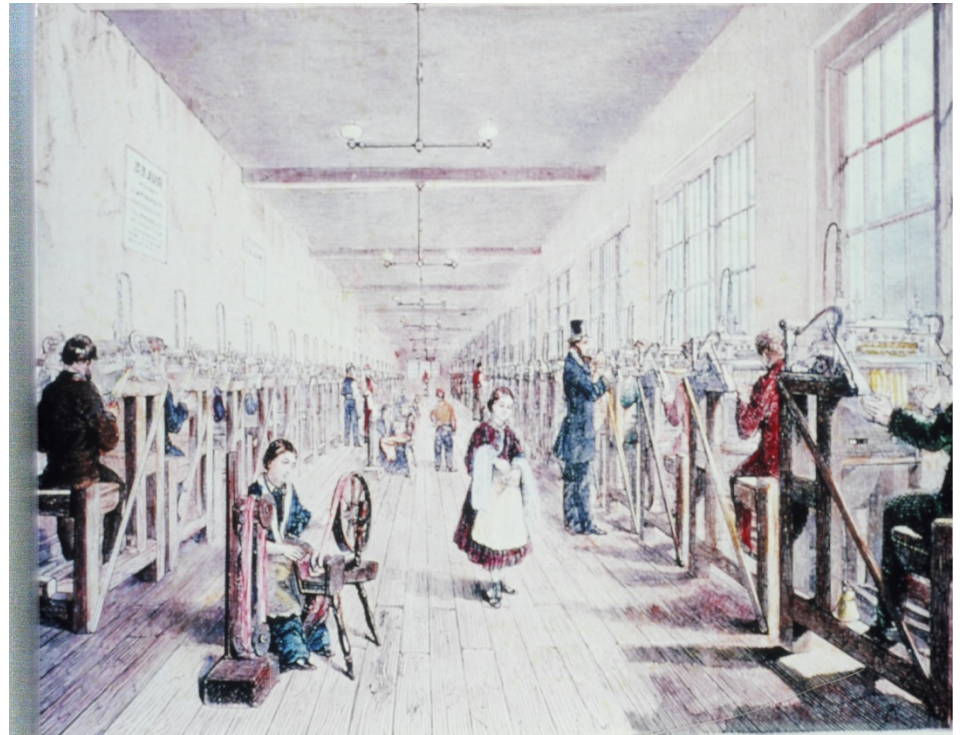
English Workers Take Control

- Labor unions – established 1824
- Won right to strike 1870
- Bargained for better wages , shorter working hours and improved working condttions

 - Created own community: provided food, housing and education for workers



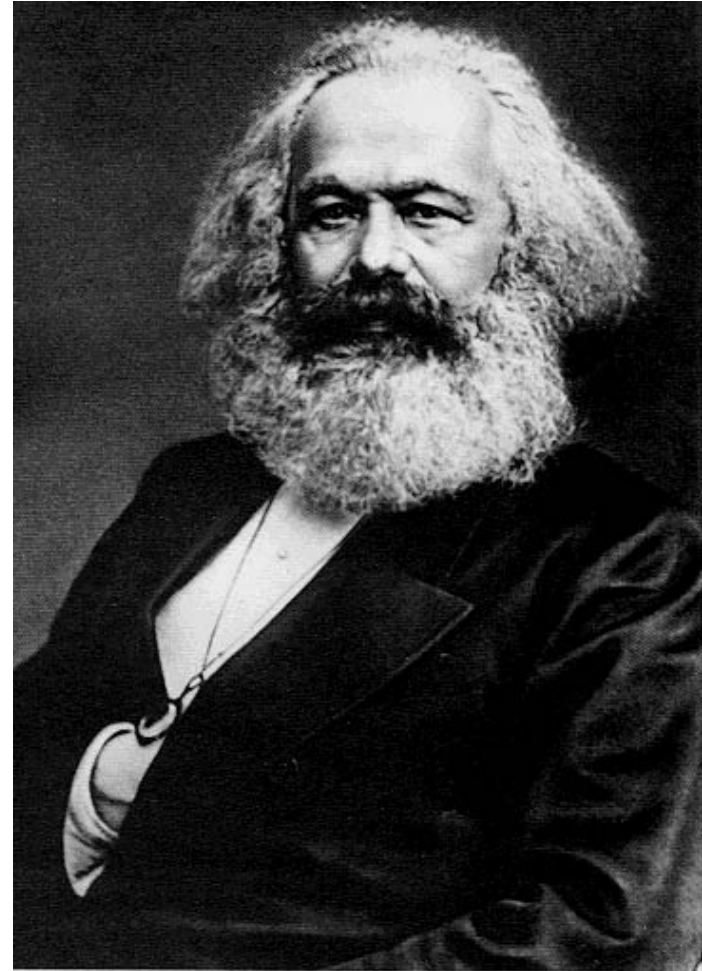
UTOPIAN IDEAS EMBRACED: Robert Owen
