CAPITALISM

- · Private ownership of industry
- Freedom of competition
- Results in unequal economic classes



CLASS STRUGGLE

• Upper class and working class struggle over wealth



WORKERS REVOLT

• Working class carries out plan to overtake upper class



SOCIALISM

- Government ownership of industry
- Goal is to bring economic equality
- Aims for a classless society



COMMUNISM

- Goal of classless acciety achieved
- No government needed

CAPITALISM

- · Students started with their own tokens
- · Students played Rock, Scissors, Paper
- · Some students won, most lost



CLASS STRUGGLE

Discussed how winners and losers felt



WORKERS REVOLT

• Planned to get tokens back (for ex., by stealing) and argued about game's fairness



SOCIALISM

- Teacher (government) collected tokens
- Teacher redistributed tokens equally
- · Students all have same amount of tokens



COMMUNISM

- · Students would refuse to play game again and choose to share tokens
- · Teacher would no longer need to supervise
