
#### African Kingdoms Before European Colonization (1870s)\*







# Challenges of Becoming Independent Right Side


- After WWII more and more African nations began to demand independence (1946-1960).
- Some new African nations enjoyed peace and democracy, others plunged into dictatorship, military rule, civil war, and corruption








# Conflicts in Africa by Ethnic Region




## **Economic Challenges**

  - Heath care



## Nigeria



- 1. 100s of ethnic groups but three dominate: Ibo and Yoruba (Christian, south), Housa (Muslim, north). Conflict – Biafra established by Ibo to protest Muslim dominated government.
- 2. capitalism resource development oil led to corruption and civil war
- 3. military rule until 1999 but still corruption and crime.


