- Paul Rusesabagina sheltered 1268 Tutsi & Hutu refugees at the Milles Collines Hotel in Kigali.
 - Paul & Tatiana now live in Belgium w/ their children, Roger, Diane, Lys, Tresor and their adopted nieces Anais and Carine.
- Tatiana's brother Thomas and his wife Fedens were never found.





Today, at the Hôtel des Mille Collines, depicted in the film "Hotel Rwanda," there is little sign of the mass killings that convulsed Rwanda in 1994.

- United Nations Security Council adopted Resolution 955, creating International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda (ICTR)
- In 2002, Gen. Bizimungu was captured in Angola and transported to the UN War Crimes Tribunal in Tanzania
- Interhamwe leader George Rutaganda--Guilty w/ Life Sentence

- The genocide ended in July 1994, when Tutsi rebels drove the Hutu army and the Interhamwe militia across the border into the Congo.
 - They left behind almost a million corpses.
