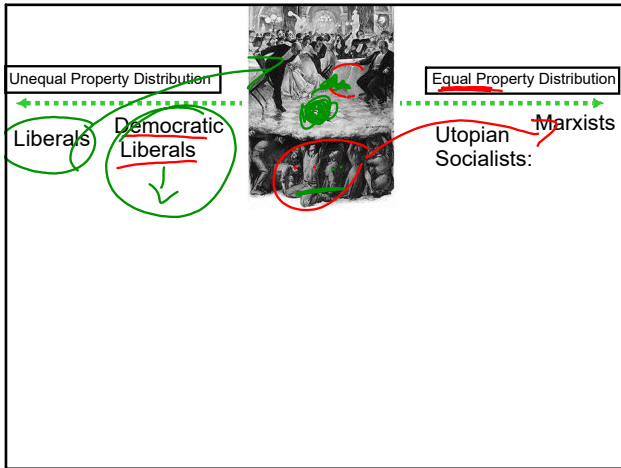

Verse:
 The Industrial Age brought a major change
 The rural way of life began to fade away
 The way people worked changed, and how things were made
 Transportation grew with steamboats and trains
 Britain led the way, with resources high
 People invested capital into enterprises
Entrepreneurs started new businesses
 They managed and assumed the financial risks
 Eli Whitney helped the textile industry
 With the cotton gin that separated cotton from seeds
 The rapid growth of city populations
 The Industrial Revolution brought **urbanization**
 Lower class workers lived packed within
 Small apartments in buildings called **tenements**
 There was a major decline in living conditions
 A radical solution was **socialism**
 Where the people as a whole own the **means of production**
 Karl Marx said the community should run this
 In practice, **communism** would be
 A system where government's led by a small elite
