Class

- 1. Students(M.E.) needed money
- 2. Students(W.C.) needed oil
- 3. Students made agreements not knowing where oil would be discovered

Middle East

- 1. M.E. countries were bankrupt in 19th C
- 2. Oil powered machines increased need for oil
- 3. M.E. and W.C. made concessions not knowing if oil would be discovered

- 4. Students gave up all oil tokens after oil was discovered (R 1)
- 5. Students signed 50/50 agreements(R2)
- 6. Some students signed charter to sell oil at a fixed price
- 7. Students paid more for oil in later rounds

- 4. Early concessions forced M.E. to give W.C all oil discovered
- 5. Arab nationalism led to better concessions for M.E.
- 6. OPEC(Organization of Petroleum Exporting Countries) formed in 1960
- 7. Starting in 1970's W.C. pay higher prices for oil
